

Utah Inmate Population

- Over 7,000 inmates statewide
- 3,900 at the Draper Site
- 1,600 at the Gunnison Site
- 1,700 located in county jails throughout the state



Clinical Services Bureau

Who We Are

150 Medical/Mental Health staff statewide.

RNs, EMTs, LCTs, PhDs, PT, Pharmacists, PA, NPs, MDs and an OD.

Annual budget of \$28,000,000.

We are state employees and certified corrections officers.



Annual Cost/Inmate/Year







Mobile Health Care


- Primary care county jail circuit
- Centralized pharmacy
- Intake medical classification system
- Tele-psychiatry
- Mentally ill offender program





On-site Care Expansion

- Hemo-dialysis 72 per month
- HIV Clinic 10 per month
- Ophthalmology 5 per month
- Telemedicine 100 per month
- MRI 20 per month
- Ultrasound 20 per month
- Oral Surgeon 25 per month
- **Over 200 transports avoided**






Multi-site Ready

- We are centralized
- We care for our patients over great distances
- Allocation of resources logical and efficient
- In line with efforts begun many years ago
- Some services are unavoidably offsite



Off Site Needs

- Off site transports are unavoidable.
- Remote sites will be costly.
- UUMC Specialty visits – diagnostic, consultation, therapeutic or level of care. 200/mo.
- UUMC ED 22/mo
- Other: Fitwell/audiologist/GVH/ etc 20/mo





Proximity to Health Care Provider

- Advanced diagnostics, specialty and inpatient
- At least one of the facilities to serve as a medical/mental health hub.
- It would need to be near health care services.
- Concept of an intake/classification and Health Care satellite prison located on Wasatch front.
